Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Thursday, December 4th a Hallmark Production called “The Good Witch” will do some taping of the movie in our school gymnasium (All day), out in front of the doors to the childcare (Approx. 9:30 a.m.) and in the staff room after school hours. One scene will be shot in the hallway above the gym during the day, however, this will be done during a time when no students or staff are in that area of the hall and security will ensure none of the movie crew have access to the school.

The H.W.C.D.S.B. has approved this taping to take place and ensured that there will be security for the regular school day to run without interruption. The school will have the security barriers up to ensure the crew stays within the confines of the gymnasium and security staff have been hired to ensure our school day is not interrupted or interfered with during the taping.

Classes will be allowed to view the taping of the show from the hallway windows above the gymnasium for a firsthand look at a live taping of a movie. The director will also make visits to some classes to answer questions and speak to the students. Security will be provided throughout the day to ensure the safety of staff and students.

In the morning, parents/guardians will still be able to use the kiss and ride lane to drop off the children. Unfortunately, throughout the day the staff parking area will be used by the movie crew for the parking of their vehicles and equipment.
